

What to do After an Accident

1. Try to remain calm! Take a few deep breaths.
2. If you or your passengers are injured call 911.
3. If able, take pictures (use cell phone camera) of the damage to your car the other car and the area of the accident.
4. If blocking traffic, pull off to side of road or well lit parking lot after pictures taken.
5. Call police if no one has done so to report accident.
6. Take down other driver's information. Get witness contact info.
7. Make sure thoughts clear before speaking with police. Get police officer contact information.
8. Do not comment on accident. Keep notes / information to yourself.
9. Assist police with their official report just state facts. Get a copy of the police report.
10. Seek medical treatment to ensure proper healing of injury and decreases in residual symptoms.
11. If attorney representation is necessary, we may be able to advise you on a qualified, reputable and experienced firm.
12. Keep receipts and statements of medical treatments or other expenses pertinent to car accident in order to get reimbursed if there is settlement.
